- Members of the public in the gallery must not operate recording equipment at a Council or Special Committee Meeting without the prior written consent of Council.
- It is an offence for any person, not being a Councillor, who is guilty of any improper or disorderly conduct to not leave the meeting when requested by the Chairperson to do so.
 Penalty: 20 Penalty Units
- It is an offence for any person to fail to obey a direction of the Chairperson relating to the conduct of the meeting and the maintenance of order.
 Penalty: 20 Penalty Units

A penalty unit for a Local Law made under Part 5 of the *Local Government Act* 1989 is \$100 in accordance with s110(2) of the *Sentencing Act* 1991.

NOMINATIONS FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR

In accordance with Meeting Procedure Local Law 2013 in regard to determining the Election of Mayor and Deputy Mayor, the Chief Executive, Mr Kelvin Tori administered the nomination and voting process with all Councillors prior to this meeting (nomination documents are appended to these minutes).

1. APPOINTMENT OF TEMPORARY CHAIRPERSON

Chief Executive, Mr Kelvin Tori, first temporary Chairperson and Returning Officer, declares the meeting open and calls for nominations for the second temporary Chairperson.

Cr Ramsey was nominated by Cr Bentley and seconded by Cr Dunn. Cr Ramsey accepted the nomination put by Cr Bentley.

There being no further nominations the Chief Executive declared that Cr Ramsey be elected as temporary Chairperson.

Cr Ramsey assumed the Chair as temporary Chairperson.

2. ADDRESS BY OUTGOING MAYOR

The outgoing Mayor Cr Ramsey addressed the gallery in relation to her Mayoral year.

3. CONFIRMATION OF MAYORAL & COUNCILLOR ALLOWANCES 2015-2016

That in accordance with Section 74(1) of the *Local Government Act 1989* and Council's adopted 2015/16 Budget, the Mayoral and Councillor Allowance be set at the maximum applicable to Category 3 Council as prescribed in the order in Council 'as made from time to time', currently at \$96,638.69 per annum as Mayoral Allowance and \$30,881.19 per annum as Councillor Allowance, which includes an amount equal to the superannuation guarantee contribution, currently 9.5%.
