We state that we are categorically opposed to the site of 26 Crestmont Drive being used for the purpose of a Youth Community Centre for the following reasons

A youth centre already exists close to the Woodgrove shopping centre.

A problem of hooning already exist in the street, in note, we requested a traffic calming device to be placed in the street in an attempt to deal with this issue.
