*In Victoria, the value of a penalty unit is set on 1 July each year by the Department of Treasury and Finance, under authority granted by section 5(3) of the Monetary Units Act 2004.*

*The current value of a Penalty Unit (PU) in Victoria is \$165.22.*

*As a term of reference the Local Government Act 2020 sets a limit on the financial penalties that Council can impose for the contravention of a local law. For a single offence the penalty cannot exceed the maximum of 20 'Penalty Units' (s79 (1)(a)), and If a Council does not expressly prescribe a penalty for the contravention of a specific local law, a Court cannot impose a penalty exceeding 10 Penalty Units (s79(2)).*
