

Development of Morton Homestead Reserve

Project Information



Project Overview:

The development of Morton Homestead Reserve will service the local community and users of the Taylors Hill Men's Shed and Morton Homestead.

Upgrades to the Reserve are intended to encourage a range of active and passive play, social gathering, connection and interaction, and recreation activities catering to a diverse demographic.

Since the project's inception, the design of Morton Homestead Reserve has undergone extensive consultation with the community and local user groups to ensure the delivery of a safe, functional and beautiful space.

The following key features will be delivered:

- Shelter with BBQ facilities
- Picnic tables with chess boards
- Casual seating throughout the reserve
- Two play spaces
- Nature play areas and sand pit
- Fitness area with exercise equipment
- Drinking fountain with dog bowl
- Concrete and compacted gravel footpaths
- Garden beds
- Planter boxes
- Expansive grass area
- New tree planting

Anticipated Construction Period:

Construction is anticipated to commence September 2019 with the park to open to the public in early 2020.

What will this mean for you?

The Reserve will be closed during construction to maintain public safety and to complete the construction works as quickly as possible.

Council will do everything possible to minimise impact to the public during the construction period.

The upgrade of Morton Homestead Reserve is a jointly funded project between Melton City Council and the Victorian Government.
