#### Record rainfall...

October has seen the wettest month on record and this has resulted in waterlogged ground conditions that have delayed progress on both the oval and pavilion works.

We're working with both the contractors on site to progress where possible and will be regularly monitoring the timeframes for completion.

Preparation for the concrete slab is continuing slowly as conditions allow. There is earthworks and placement of void forming panels and insulation to complete before the slab is poured.
