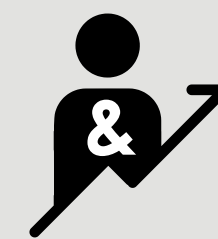

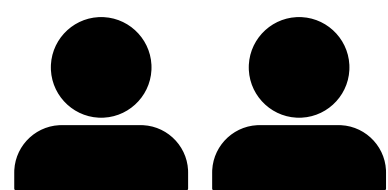

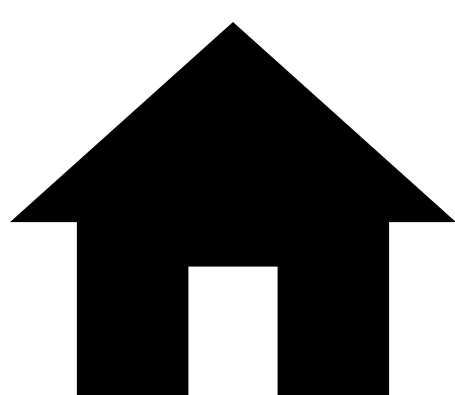

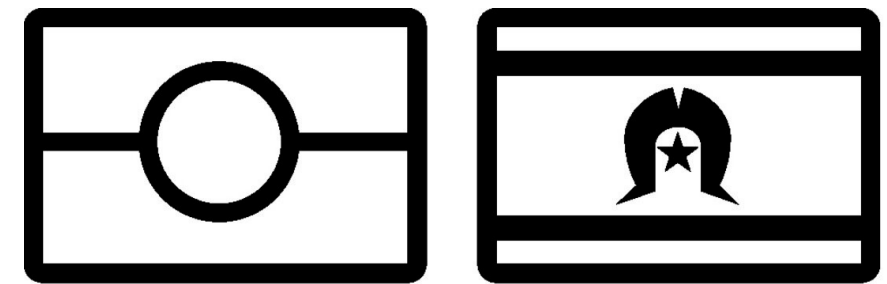

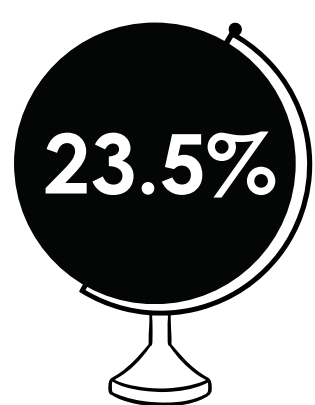

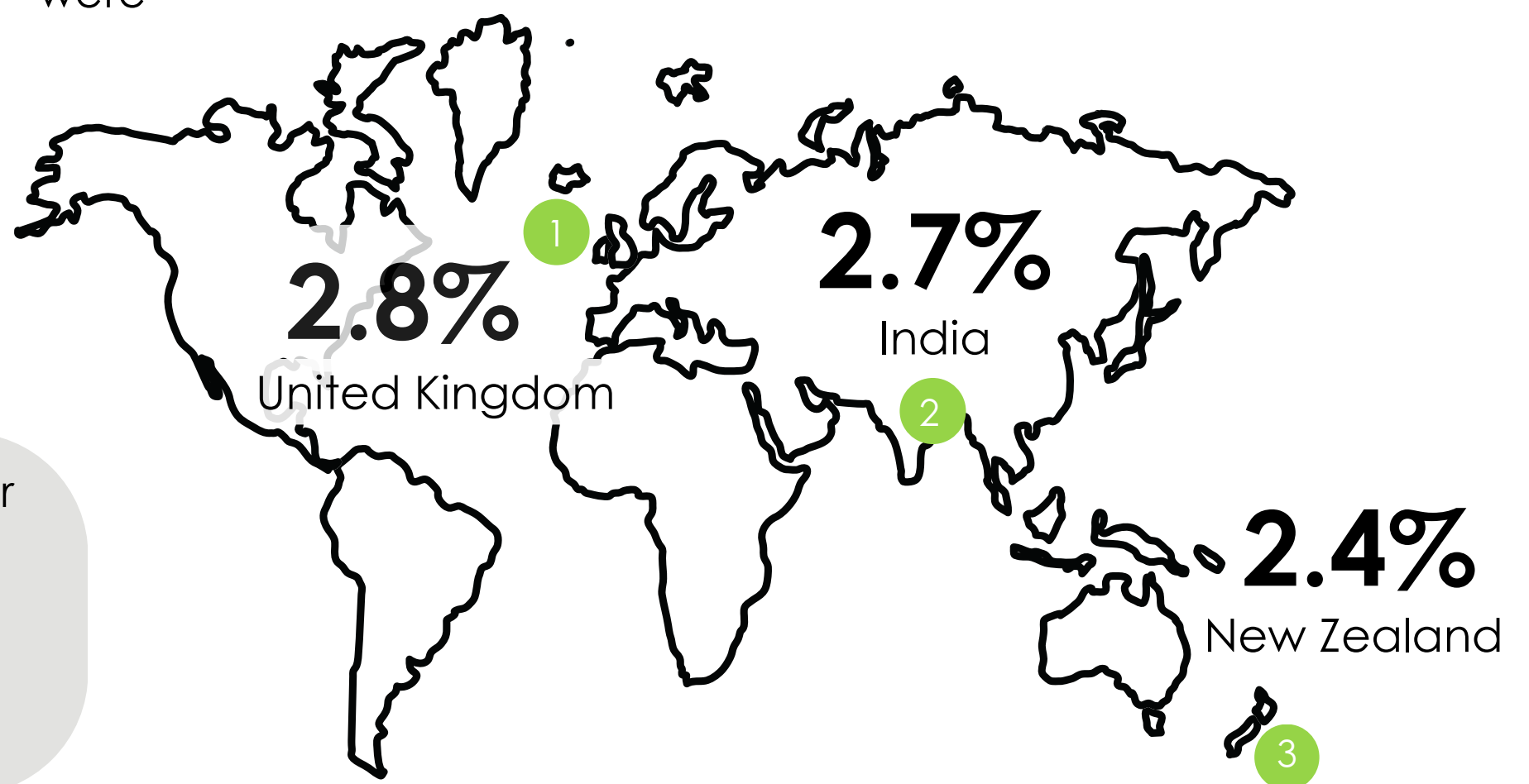


Place of birth

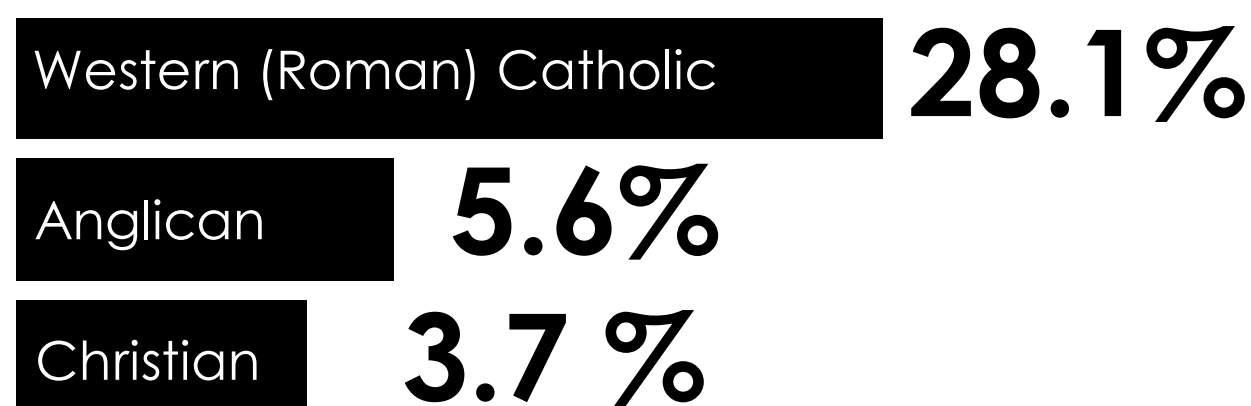

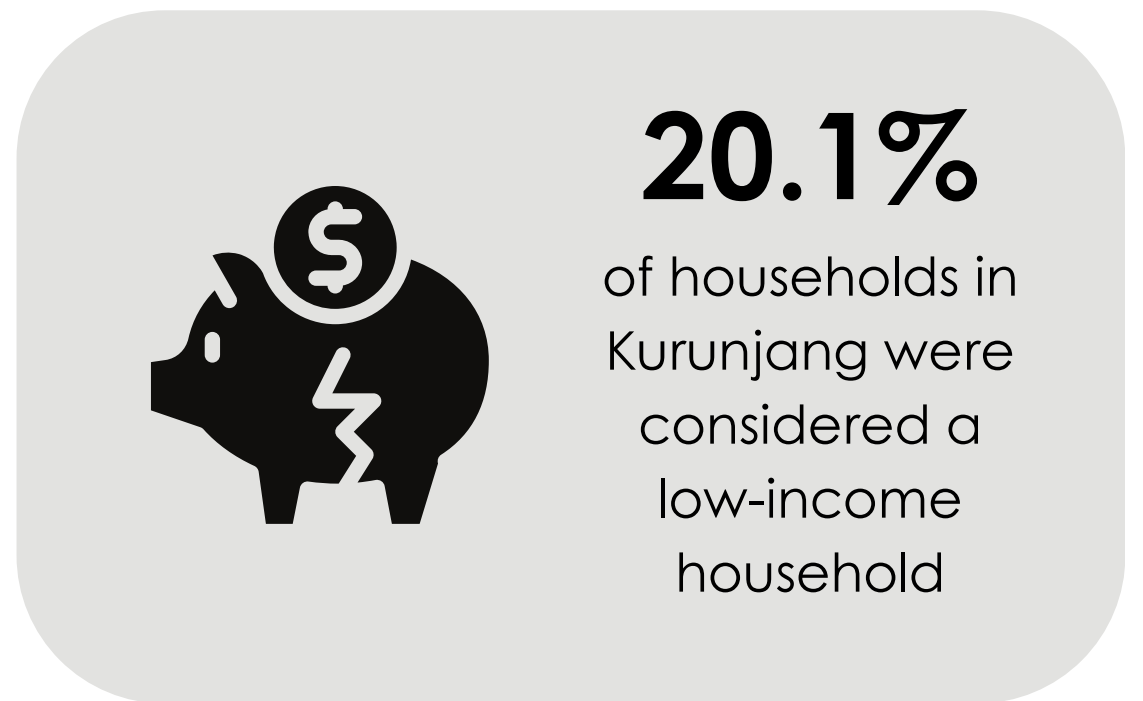
