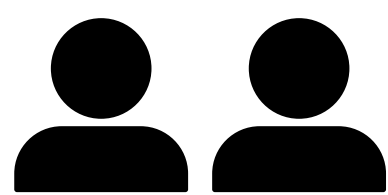

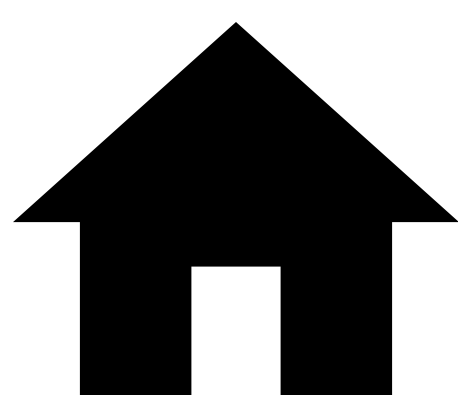

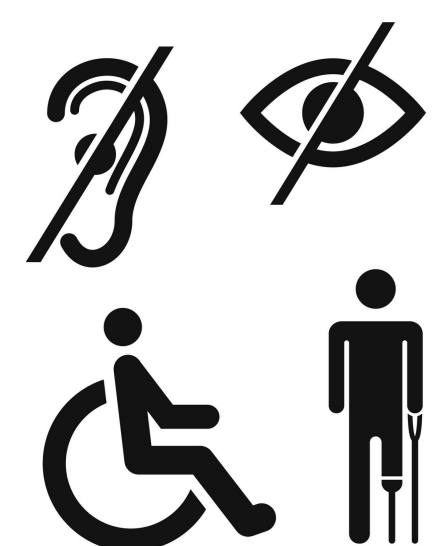

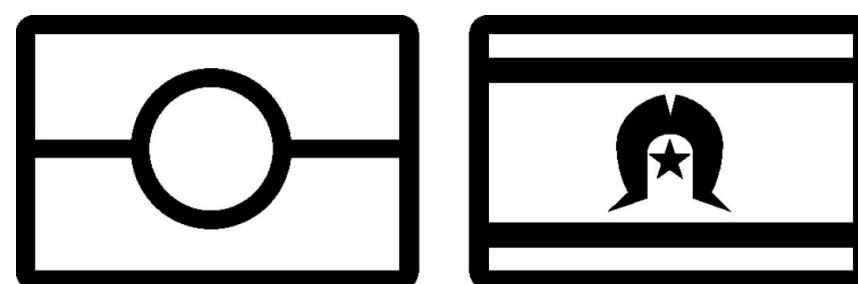

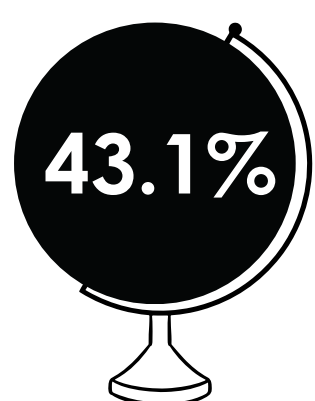

Place of birth

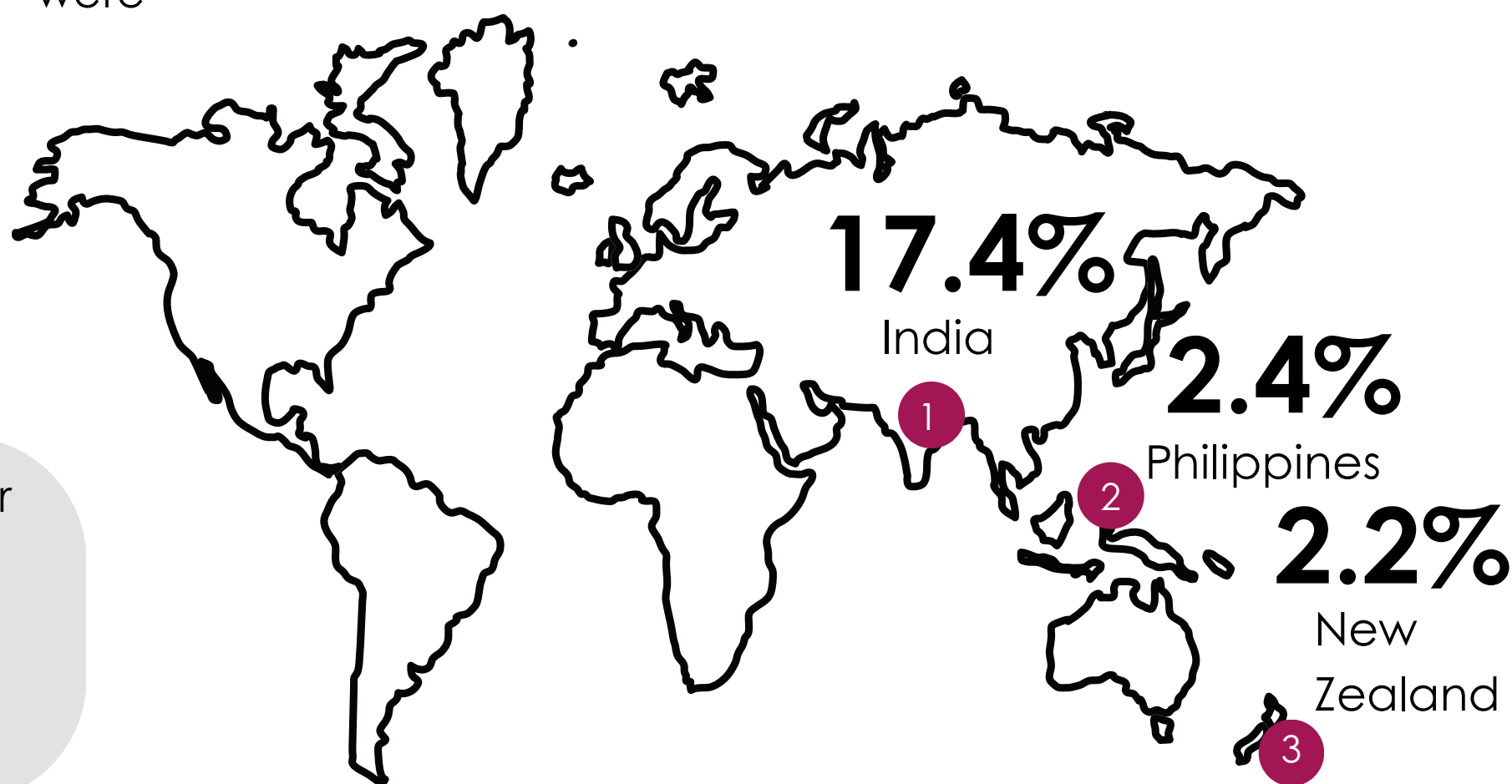
The top three countries of birth outside of Australia for Rockbank were

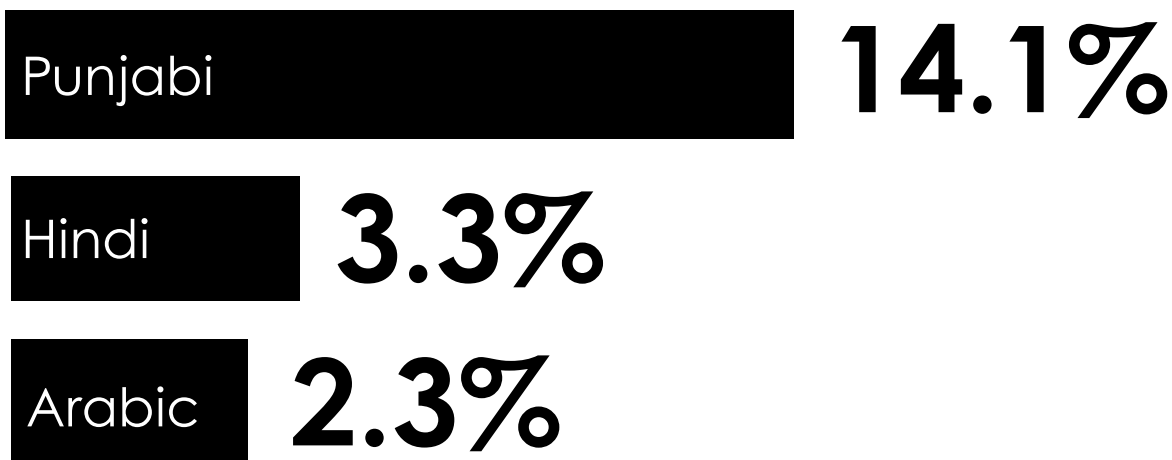

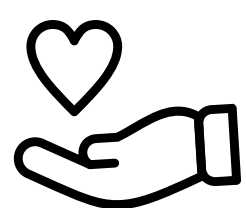

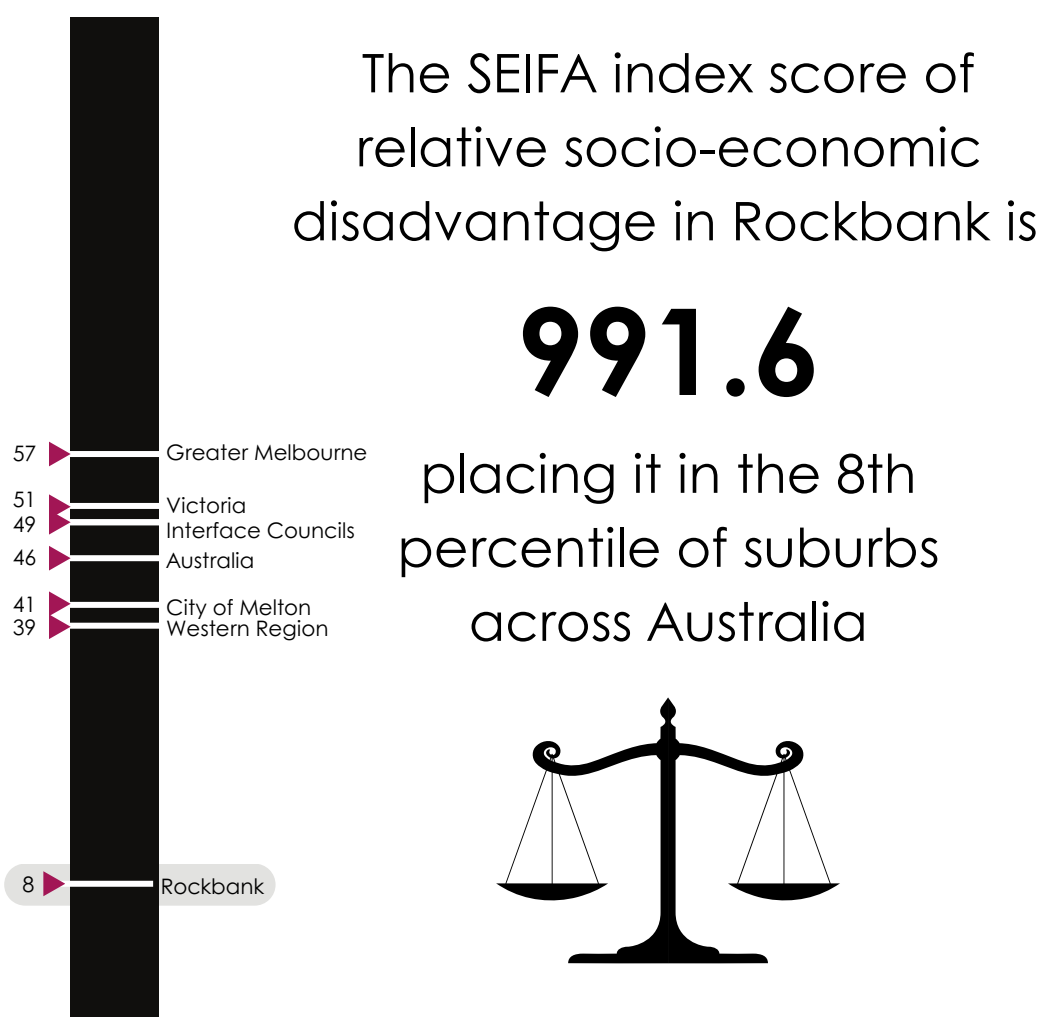
of people in Rockbank over 15 provided unpaid care to children - this equates to 630 people. Of these, 93 were caring for children other than their own.




Financial stress


