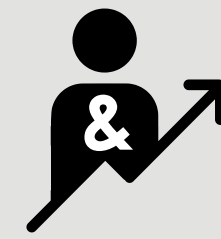

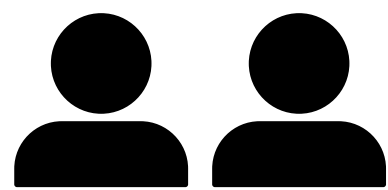

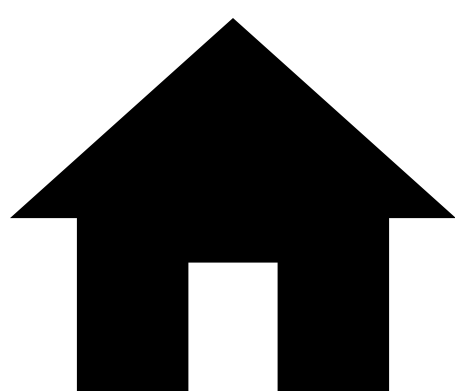

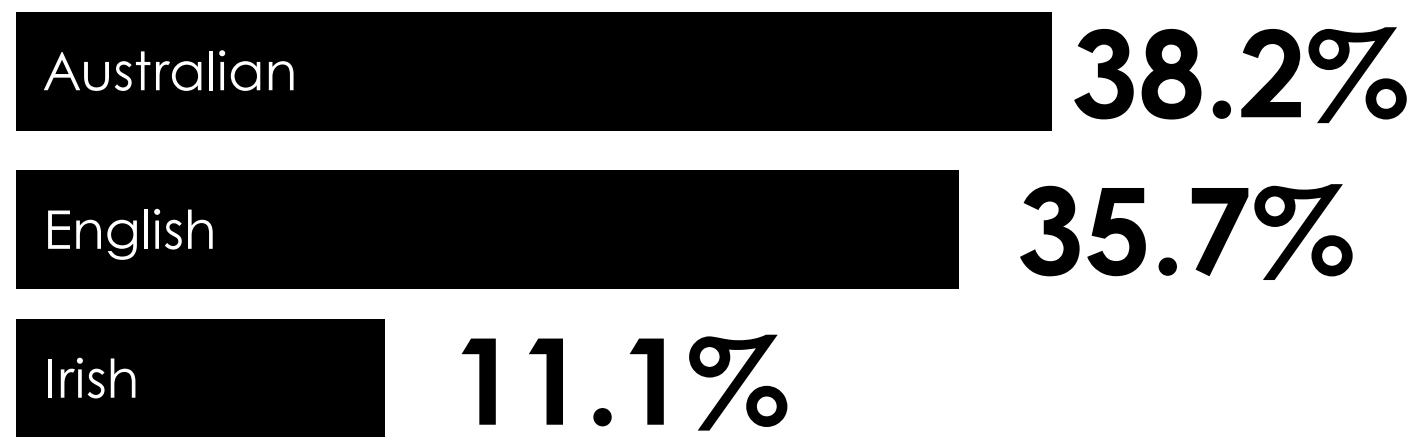

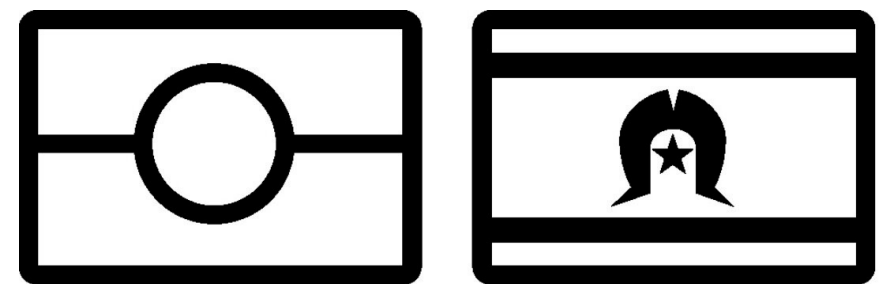

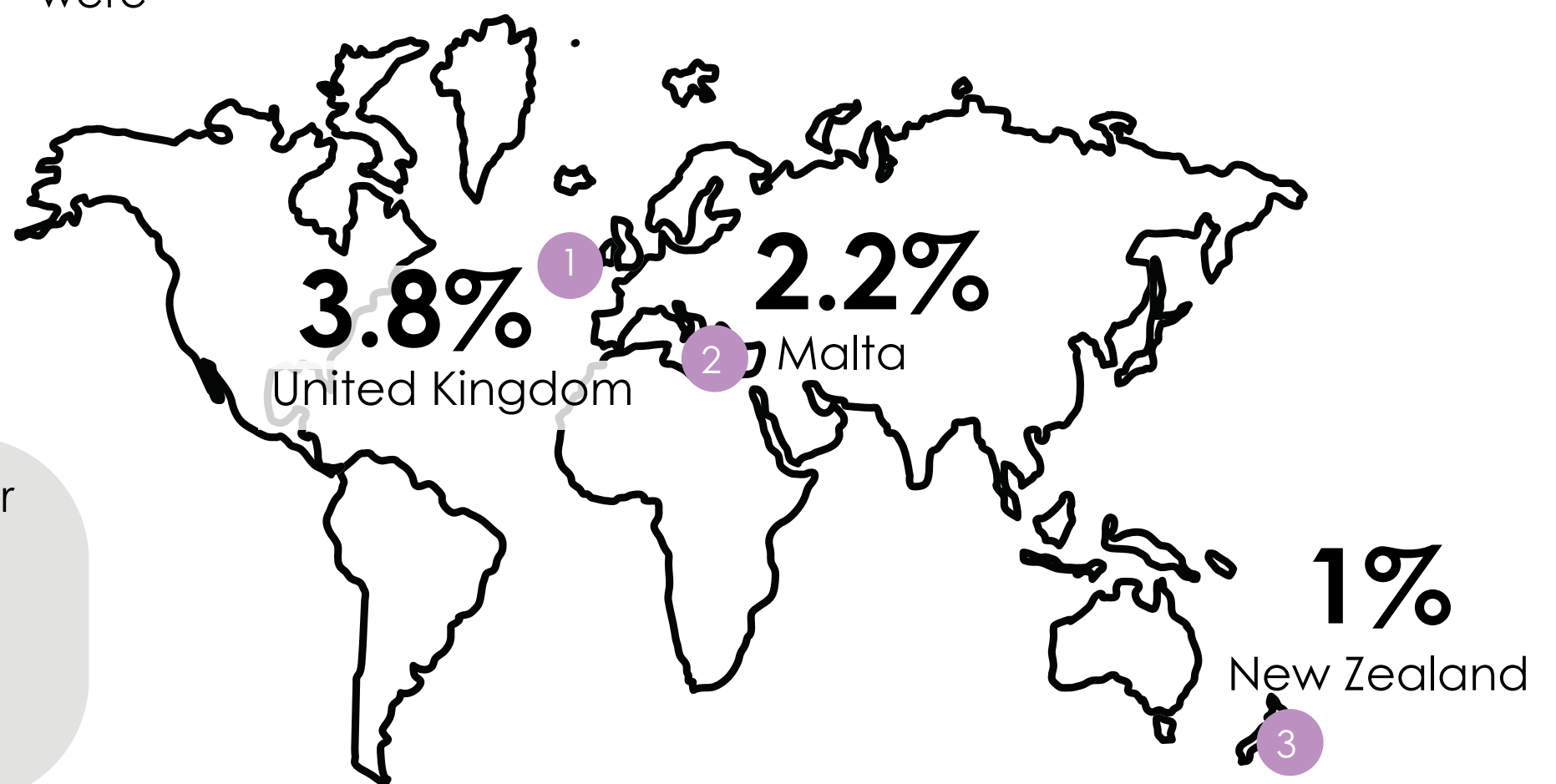


Place of birth

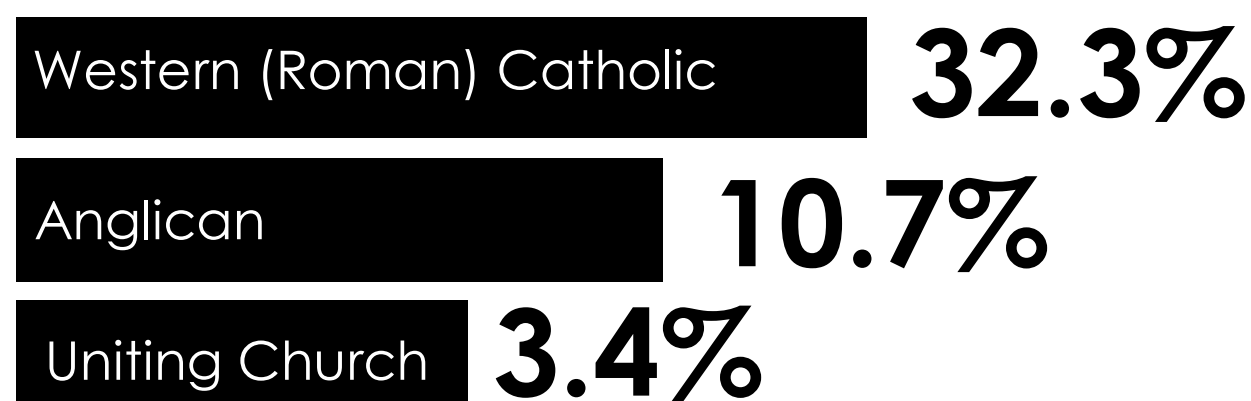

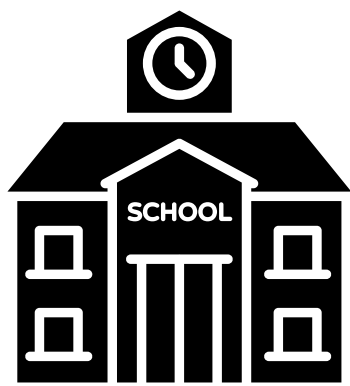

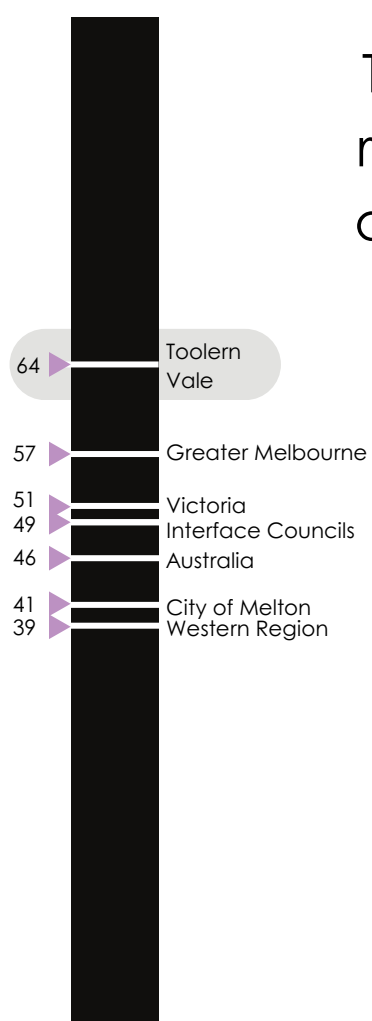
of people in Toolern Vale over 15 provided unpaid care to children - this equates to 191 people. Of these, 62 were caring for children other than their own.

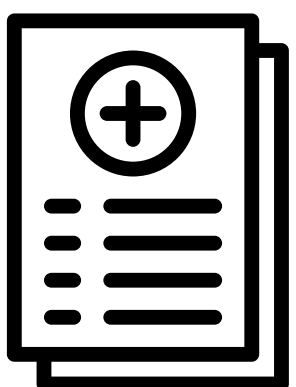
