

Bill Cahill Reserve is a 2.2 hectare existing park situated on Hume Ave, Melton South, which faces great challenges to better accommodate a variety uses to meet increasingly social and recreation needs of the community. This masterplan responds to the challenges to better connect and improve the existing park making it a central meeting point for local community and also a highly utilised recreation space for multi-aged users. In addition it will meet an identified gap in the open space network to ensure that the community has equitable access to open space. It aims to provide cost effective outcomes to meet the Council budget whilst ensuring a upgraded level of functionality and provision of flexible, useful spaces.
