Planning for growth

Together with joint venture partner Lendlease, Council is developing 480 hectares of land in Melton South to support the growing needs of the community.

Council has managed the development of a variety of community facilities within the Bridge Road Precinct including an award-winning Children's and Community Centre, accredited athletics track and hockey pitch, sports pavilion and a regional play space.

Future plans for the precinct integrate the current services with 75 hectares of parkland along the Toolern Creek, a proposed future school, tennis courts, a traffic school and oval.
