Vital infrastructure transforms Melton's centre

Strong cooperative partnerships with both State and Federal Government have enabled Council to deliver Pride of Melton, a cornerstone development aimed at reinvigorating Melton's town centre, strengthening the local economy and inspiring pride within the community.

The \$14.3 million staged-project includes a number of street upgrades and beautification works, a new and revitalised town square, cultural and community events space (amphitheatre) and open space.

Improved connectivity for the community to key shopping precincts, Visitor Information Centre, bus interchange and Melton Library and Learning Hub and enhanced pedestrian and bicycle access and outdoor dining, create a modern, attractive and functional public space.

- \$14.3 million invested in infrastructure via strong privatepublic partnerships
- Two of the five stages completed, remaining stages to be completed by the end 2019
- A complete transformation of the Melton Town Centre
- Open space within the township
- Vital high-quality infrastructure
- A converted courthouse, now a bustling café
- A new amphitheatre; a significant community event space
- Ample open-space and improved community access and connectivity to retail area the Melton Library and Learning Hub
