Strong partnerships building exceptional infrastructure

This highly anticipated precinct was purpose-built for the development and growth of the community's younger residents and focuses on the integration of services in one central location.

Council worked cooperatively with the State Government to integrate a Children's and Community Centre within the P-9 school, resulting in the provision of child care services, a maternal and child health centre, kindergarten and occasional care under one roof. This unique project was jointly designed, funded and delivered by Council and the State Government.

Strategic alliances have also delivered shared construction of a three-court indoor stadium, a shared use library and sporting grounds.

Council provides students with full access to adjoining community sporting facilities.
