Is the principal entrance self-opening, or easy to see and open?	\bigcirc
Is the principal entrance door handle at a height that is easy for all customers to reach?	\bigcirc
Within the business, is there sufficient space for easy manoeuvrability? I.e. wide, clear internal walkways between furniture for a person using a wheelchair, walking frame, or stroller.	\bigcirc
Are accessible sanitary facilities provided with an 'access sign'?	\bigcirc
Where possible, an accessible toilet should be provided in premises where customers may be spending a long period of time (such as restaurants and cafes).	\bigcirc
If you do not have an accessible toilet, do all staff know the location of the nearest accessible toilet?	\bigcirc
Within the business, are the products/services easily accessed?	\bigcirc
Is there seating with backs and armrests available?	\bigcirc
Is there suitable height and space at tables for people using wheelchairs or with assistance animals (e.g., guide or hearing dog)? - Tables to be 700-850mm above the platform/ground height.	
Is an "Assistance Available" sticker present at the business?	Ø
