- I understand that the activities at the Men's Sheds are overseen by Council Volunteers known as Shed Team Leaders.
- I acknowledge that I am in good health and that I have disclosed any medical, safety or health conditions which may impact my ability to participate at the Men's Shed with a Men's Shed representative. Where requested, I will provide a medical clearance from my medical practitioner before I am permitted to participate in Men's Shed activities.
- If my health changes during my membership at the Men's Shed, I will consult with a Men's Shed Team Leader as soon as reasonably practicable.
- I acknowledge that Shed Team Leaders and the Sheds Program Officer are not certified healthcare professionals and are not responsible for my personal care or support whilst I am in attendance at the Mens Shed or participating in activities associated with my Mens Shed membership.
- I commit to following the Men's Shed Code of Behaviour and adhering to the Melton City Council **Men's Shed Policy** which is attached to this Application Form.
- I authorise a Council Officer or Shed Team Leader to contact my emergency contact, in the event of a health or other emergency.
- I acknowledge that I must abide by the Men's Shed Code of Behaviour (**the Code**) and understand that your membership to the Men's Shed may be revoked at the sole discretion of Council if there is a breach of the Code.

Melton City Council Men's Shed Code of Behaviour

We ask that you work to ensure everyone's experience at the Men's Shed is positive, by following this code of behaviour:

- Treat all members with respect and courtesy. Violent, threatening, discriminatory or intimidating behaviour is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.
- Listen and follow instructions provided by Shed Team Leaders and Melton City Council staff.
- Ensure tools and equipment are cleaned after use and returned to their designated space. Notify Melton City Council staff or Shed Team Leaders of any faults or damages.
- Assistance Dogs are welcome, other animals are not.
- Ensure your work area is cleaned and free of obstructions, and that your work does not interfere with other Shed activities.
- The Shed is an alcohol and illicit drug free zone. Anyone who is under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs will be asked to leave the premises immediately.
- Smoking and vaping are not permitted inside or within 10 metres of the Shed.
- Service providers and/or support workers supporting participants during a visit to the Shed must take responsibility for their client abiding by the above rules and facilitate active participation in Shed activities at all times.
