02 September 2024	Steve Abboushi	Blackwood Drive Recreation Reserve works for 2024/2025 budget.	<p>Please find below a list of current (ongoing) and proposed sport and recreation projects for the Blackwood Drive Recreation Reserve in Council's current and planned Capital program:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Facility Kitchen compliance upgrade. The power upgrade required to undertake the compliance kitchen upgrade has commenced. The Design for the kitchen layout is being finalised. The power upgrade has delayed this project 12 months.</li> <li>• Preparation of a concept plan to guide future upgrades to the pavilion and sportsgrounds for rugby union and cricket. Consultants brief/s being finalised to go to quote expected to be completed by early 2025. In light of the kitchen upgrade above, the intent is to ensure compliance of the existing kitchen as the concept plan may recommend significant building moderations for the building in the future.</li> <li>• Electronic scoreboard planned delivery as per adopted Council report (2025/26)</li> <li>• Pavilion upgrades to ensure compliance with facility standards for rugby and cricket (2026/27) These include extending the community social room to 130m2, upgrading the amenities, providing additional storage and ensuring the umpires rooms are female friendly. This will be determined by the feasibility and concept plan outlined above.</li> <li>• Sportsground upgrades (2027/28). This will include redeveloping the main oval and reconfiguring the layout to accommodate 2 senior sized rugby fields, relocating the sportsground lighting, providing player and spectator shelters and replacing the fencing.</li> </ul>
01 October 2024		Are there plans to seal Mt Cottrell Road?	<p>At its meeting on 16 September 2024, Council resolved to award a works order to seal the unsealed section of Mt Cottrell Road between Alfred Road and Iramoo Circuit.</p> <p>These works are expected to commence in November 2024, subject to finalisation of contract arrangements.</p>
26 September 2024	Sophie Ramsey	Status of the Rockbank Precinct Structure Plan, and the status of the Rockbank Major Town Centre permit application	<p>I provide the following information in relation to queries associated with the Rockbank Major Town Centre.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Rockbank Major Town Centre is identified in the Rockbank Precinct Structure Plan that was approved in 2016.</li> <li>• The Rockbank Major Town Centre Urban Design Framework, adopted by Council in 2019, includes design requirements to ensure that our town centres are well designed for the benefit of our residents.</li> <li>• A planning permit for initial stages of the Rockbank Major Town Centre was issued in December 2022.</li> </ul>
04 October 2024	Kathy Majdlik	Beware of Snake Signs	<p>I can confirm Council's Parks &amp; Open Space contractor, GLG do install these signs each Spring/Summer time in a number of locations throughout the municipality.</p> <p>Signs are installed following snake sightings either by staff at the time of conducting site services or by members of the public via a Customer Action Request.</p> <p>GLG has advised that they typically install 40-50 signs during the Spring/Summer season and the signs are gradually removed as from the beginning of Autumn.</p> <p>I have requested Council officers review this process and determine whether we would be better placed installing more permanent signage in key locations as an alternative to the temporary signs.</p>
15 October 2024		Taylor's Road Intersection at Atwell Estate Deanside	<p>This intersection will be upgraded with traffic lights and will be constructed by the developer. Currently the developer has just begun their preliminary service detection work. As this is a developer lead project Council have limited control as to when they will begin construction proper but it is expected to be before the end of the year. 15 October 2024		Plans for Council Land, land located at 1 Greaves Avenue	The approximately 6-hectare parcel of land located at 1 Greaves Avenue, Deanside is earmarked for the future development of the Kororoit East Recreation Reserve. The delivery of the reserve is expected to occur by 2036. Sports facility planning undertaken recommends the reserve be developed as an athletics and rugby union facility however given timing this will regularly be reviewed to ensure at the time of preplanning occurring the appropriate mix of recreation uses are provided for the community.
